Therefore, it signed an agreement on September 6, 2024, with CNIB. This organization provides community support to blind or partially sighted Canadians to ensure they have the self-confidence, skills and opportunity to fully realize themselves in society.

In summary, here are the services offered:

Audio format (Daisy and MP3) — Bilingual production team and narrators.

Document remediation — Tagging elements of PDF documents and providing a reading experience in accordance with the document creator's intent.

Braille transcription — Transcription into braille dots that can be read by braille reading software or by touch on embossed paper.

Interpretation services — LSQ/French and ASL/English remotely and in person (depending on location).
